## **Personal information collection – MOS may collect and use the following:**

- Information about your use of our organization website

- Any other information that you send to MOS in the course of operating our non-profit organization

In addition to the disclosures reasonably necessary for the purposes identified elsewhere above, MOS may disclose your personal information to the extent that it is required to do so by law, in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings and in order to establish, exercise or defend its legal rights.

- MOS will store all the personal information you provide on its secure servers
