

George Mason University Wins Four U.S. Department of Defense Nunn-Perry Awards



George Mason University received four Nunn-Perry Awards from the U.S. Department of Defense for outstanding achievement in the Mentor-Protégé Program. The University was a member on each of the following teams: Raytheon – New England Die Cutting; Parsons – Mobius Consulting; QED – Mills Marine; & Raytheon – TRM Microwave. There were a total of eight winners of the 2017 DOD Nunn-Perry Award and all were honored at the Mentor-Protégé Conference in Orlando, Florida August 14 – 16, 2018. The Nunn-Perry Award is the highest honor companies can receive in the Mentor-Protégé Program.

In the Mentor-Protégé Program, mentor firms provide appropriate developmental assistance to enhance the capabilities of protégé firms to perform as subcontractors and suppliers. The mentor firms selected George Mason University to develop and install a QMS (Quality Management System) with some of the award winning protégé's while others were in need of Executive Coaching in addition to Financial System training and enhancements. Each of these areas proved to be differentiators for the protégé's and allowed them to be positioned for future prime and subcontracting opportunities.
