

TRINITY CATHEDRAL ANNUAL MEETING

JANUARY 16TH 2022

The annual meeting of Trinity Cathedral will be held on January 16th, 2022, at 11:00 o'clock in the morning. Online participation will be available. Elections for offices will be held and reports from various ministries will be presented. The 2022 budget will be presented, as well as an extensive update on the property development.

Elections will take place for the following positions

CHAPTER MEMBER As the legal representative body of the cathedral, the chapter defines the mission of the congregation; ensures effective organization and planning; and manages resources and finances. Chapter members are required to attend the regular meetings and should be available for special events at the cathedral. Chapter members are elected at the annual meeting.

DELEGATES TO THE DIOCESAN CONVENTION Delegates represent the congregation at the annual diocesan convention. Delegates are required to attend the convention during a weekend in early November. Delegates are elected by plurality. The two persons receiving the most votes are to serve as delegates; the two persons receiving the third and fourth number of votes are to serve as alternates. Alternate delegates serve at the absence of the delegates. *Two delegates and two alternate delegates are to be elected to serve.*

QUALIFICATIONS

To be eligible to run for any of the above offices, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Be regular in attendance at worship and participates in some aspect of congregational life
- Be an annual contributor of substance to the cathedral
- Be baptized in a Christian tradition and moving toward Confirmation.
