Please join us for the 2020 Census : **Municipal Ideas**

Exchange. The 2020 census is quickly approaching and a complete count ensures that local governments receive an accurate share of federal and state resources. However, much has changed since the 2010 Census. Some communities have become more diverse. The region has grown older and a new electronic Census format means that some residents may need additional reminders to participate.

The **Municipal Ideas Exchange** is intended to help municipalities and their CCCs prepare this year. The Exchange will educate on the importance of a complete, accurate and equitable count as well as offer municipalities specific steps that can be taken through their CCCs to reach the hardest-to-count residents.

MMC and convening partners **CMAP**, the **Census Bureau**, **Forefront** and other guests will help answer the following questions:

- Why is it important to have an accurate local count?
- How can municipalities ensure a complete count?
- What grants and partnerships are available?
- What are other municipalities doing and what can we learn from them?
