	COMMON NAME	SCIENTIFIC NAME	WHERE TO LOOK	CULINARY VALUE
T	Bicolor bolete	Boletus bicolor	On forest floor in hardwood forests, especially near oak	Excellent
	Porcini	Boletus edulis	On forest floor near spruce or hemlock; also near pine and occasionally in hardwood forests	Excellent
	Giant puffball	Calvatia gigantea	Lawns, agricultural fields, urban areas, disturbed ground, open woods	Good
	Smooth chanterelle	Cantharellus lateritius	On forest floor near oaks	Excellent
	Golden chanterelle	Cantharellus cibarius	On forest floor under mixed hardwoods, pine or hemlock	Excellent
7	Cinnabar-red chanterelle	Cantharellus cinnabarinus	On forest floor in hardwood forests	Excellent
T	Black trumpet	Craterellus cornucopioides	On forest floor in hardwood and coniferous forests, often growing in moss	Excellent
	Yellow foot	Craterellus ignicolor, Craterellus tubaeformis, Craterellus aurora	On forest floor or logs in coniferous bogs and sphagnum moss. Also, on ground in mossy areas in hardwood forests	Excellent
	Reishi	Ganoderma tsugae	Dead or dying hemlock	Medicinal
	Lion's mane	Hericium americanum, Hericium coralloides, Hericium erinaceus	On hardwood logs, stumps and standing trees	Very good; Medicinal

7	Hedgehog	Hydnum repandum, Hydnum umbilicatum	On forest floor in hardwood and coniferous forests	Excellent
	Lobster mushroom	Hypomyces lactifluorum	On forest floor, anwhere you have seen white Lactarius or Russula species fruiting. In both deciduous and coniferous forests, but most often under hemlock	Good
	Chicken of the woods	Laetiporus sulphureus	On dead or dying hardwoods, particularly ash. Avoid consuming specimen found on hemlock.	Good
-	Scaber stalk bolete	Leccinum sp.	On the forest floor near birch, poplar, aspen, oak, beech, spruce or pine	Mediocre
	Oyster mushroom	Pleurotus poulinus	On older Populus species - especially poplar.	Good
T	King stropharia	Stropharia rugosannulata	Wood chip mulch in suburban or landscaped areas	Good
	Saffron milky	Lactarius deliciosus	On forest floor in hardwood and coniferous forests	Good
