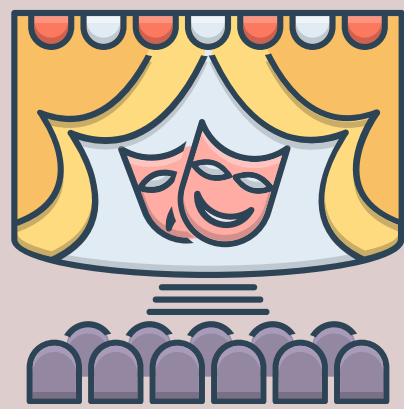
Fuel your mind
