This Scholarship is open to all senior students attending any school in Davis including Davis Senior High, DaVinci Charter Academy, King High School, Grace Valley Christian Academy, Davis School for Independent Study or students in homeschool programs. The award can be used for students wishing to attend a 4-year university, Community College, Trade/Technical school or Business College program.

Students will be required to submit a creative writing response which will be reviewed by the Davis Chamber of Commerce School Business Partnership Committee. Writing responses will be judged on content, creativity, quality, and structure.

The winner will be notified by May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 by the committee chair. The winner will be announced publicly at Celebrate Davis on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and will be presented with the check on stage at the event.

Completed submissions should include the writing response, the application, cover letter, and transcripts/acceptance letters from a college or trade school. Responses should be in 12-point font, use double spacing and be a minimum of 500 words to 1000 words maximum. An email letter will not count as a cover letter. Late applications will not be accepted. It is the student's responsibility to ensure their packets arrive by the deadline, no exception will be made.
