So often we respond to children's writing with what's wrong instead of what's right. At our next Parent Café, teachers Brandy Hurley and Jessica Wenzelburger will provide an overview of writing workshop, a method for teaching writing popularized by the Teachers College Reading and Writing Project at Columbia University.

Writing workshop provides students with the opportunity to live and work like professional writers by exposing them to multiple genres of writing, while providing students with the choice to pursue topics of meaning and value in their writing. In addition to explaining the structure of writing workshop to attendees, Mrs. Hurley and Mrs. Wenzelburger will lead a short writing exercise.

The evening will close with the sharing of high-impact ways to respond to your children's writing that will inspire them to continue creating and sharing their work.
