# 1st Offense

- Personal Communication Device will be stored in the assistant principal's office for the day, and the parent/guardian will be potified.
- A warning will be issued to both the student and the parent/guardian about further consequences for failing to comply with the cell phone-free policy
- Personal Communication Device will be returned to the <u>student</u> at the end of the day
- The offense will be recorded in Skyward, using the cell phone violation action code

#### 2nd Offense

- Personal Communication Device will be stored in the assistant principal's office for the day, and the parent/guardian will be notified
- A warning will be issued to both the student and the parent/guardian about further consequences for failing to comply with the cell phone-free policy
- Personal Communication Device will be returned to the <u>parent/guardian</u> at the end of the day
- The offense will be recorded in Skyward, using the cell phone violation action code

# 3rd Offense

- Personal Communication Device will be stored in the assistant principal's office for the day, and the parent/guardian will be notified
- Student will be issued up to 3 days of lunch detention
- Personal Communication Device will be returned to the <u>parent/guardian</u> at the end of the day
- The offense will be recorded in Skyward, using the cell phone violation action code

#### 4th Offense

- Personal Communication Device will be stored in the assistant principal's office for the day, and the parent/guardian will be notified
- Student will be issued 1 Saturday School
- Personal Communication Device will be returned to the parent/guardian at the end of the day
- The offense will be recorded in Skyward, using the cell phone violation action code

### 5th Offense & Beyond

- Personal Communication Device will be stored in the assistant principal's office for the day, and the parent/guardian will be notified
- Considered Insubordination
- Student will be issued up to 3 days of In School Suspension (ISS)
- Personal Communication Device will be returned to the parent/guardian at the end of the day
- The offense will be recorded in Skyward, using the cell phone violation action code
