Safety Guidelines

1. Drivers of floats must be at least 21 years of age, have a license for the vehicle being operated, and must have liability insurance.

2. **NO Candy or other items are allowed to be thrown from floats or vehicles.** This causes children along the route to run into the street and into the path of the parade vehicles. If you want to give candy, please have walkers along the side of the entry to pass it out.

3. Small children will not be allowed to ride on top of cars.

4. Float riders will not be allowed to hang their feet over the sides of the float. Participants must stay on the float at all times once the parade is in motion.

Parade Route**

The parade will begin at Albertville 1st Baptist Church on the corner of E. Main St. It will continue down Main St turn left at MUB on to S. Hambrick, left on to Sand Mtn. Dr. behind MUB. Follow Sand Mtn. Dr. to McDonald Ave. Turn right on to McDonald Ave, turn left on to Jackson St., left on to Baltimore Ave & end in the First Baptist Church parking lot where the parade began.

Rules & Regulations

This year's parade promises to be fun for children and adults alike. Our theme is "Christmas at the Movies."

All entries must be decorated. Keep the theme in mind, using lights and decorations to make the parade more appealing. Be creative and have fun!

- All vehicles, bands, and walking groups must be registered with the parade committee.
- Due to safety factors, four (4) wheelers & ATVs are not allowed in the parade.

- Horses must be bagged or they WILL NOT be accepted in the parade.

Floats & Vehicle Entries

Everyone should enter the First Baptist Church parking lot through the Baltimore Avenue entrance. This is the ONLY entrance. A Civitan member will be at the entrance to guide you to your line up location. Once a float, car, truck, or other similar moving vehicle arrives in the parade line-up, a driver must be with the vehicle at all times. Please be sure to have a sign with the float sponsor's name posted on both sides of the float along with decorations. There must be an adult on floats where there are children.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE DECORATED!

Walking Groups

All walking groups should meet in the grassy area at the rear of First Baptist Church parking lot. You will be directed to your line up location. For safety, we ask anyone with participants being dropped off to enter the parking lot from Baltimore Avenue, drop off the participant with a Civitan or Jr. Civitan member and exit the parking lot. YOU MAY NOT PARK in the church parking lot. The Civitan or Jr. Civitan member will walk your child to their location. This is for safety purposes to avoid additional vehicles driving thru the area while children are lining up.
