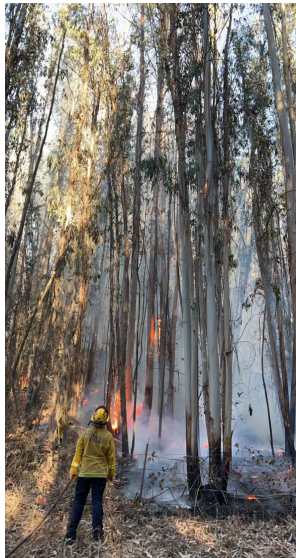

### **CAL FIRE BEU Reduces Evacuation Orders to Areas Within San Benito County**

**San Benito County** – CAL FIRE BEU is reducing the Evacuation Order to an Evacuation Warning to all areas impacted by the Anzar Fire, with the exception of homes on Forest Lane in San Benito County.

An Evacuation Warning means that it is safe to return home. However, the fire is still actively burning, and residents in the Evacuation Warning area still need to be prepared to leave quickly should the need arise.

Please be aware that there could be hazards within a burned area, including damaged trees that can fall with no warning. Also, please drive with caution around crews working in the area.
