She also holds qualifications in veterinary acupuncture, spinal integration, homeopathy, and other therapies and has authored *Healthy Dogs a Manual of Natural Therapies* (2003), *The Pet Lovers Guide to Natural Healing for Cats and Dogs* (2006) and coauthored two veterinary texts *Veterinary Herbal Medicine* (2007) and *Integrating Complementary Medicine into Veterinary Practice* (2008).
