

Cooper High School Academy of Math and Science

The Cooper High School Academy of Math and Science (CAMS) program allows students to engage in an accelerated college-level math and science program while in high school. The program is designed for motivated, high achieving students that may want to enter a science, math, or technology field. This includes engineering, mathematics, medicine, or other technical fields. This program will expose students to college admission personnel and to area science and technology programs. Additionally, some students from this academy have been selected to attend The Gatton Academy of Mathematics and Science in Kentucky after their sophomore year in high school. In fact, all four students that have applied to the Gatton Academy from the CAMS program have been accepted.

Any interested 8th grade student with a strong academic background can apply to the academy by going to www.coopercams.yolasite.com. Here you will find an application form and a sign-up for the admissions test. The admissions test will be administered on Tuesday, November 28 and Thursday, November 30 at Cooper High School from 3:00 p.m. to 5:15 p.m. Applicants will be chosen holistically based on their admissions test results, teacher recommendations, and the quality of the application. Students will be notified of their acceptance status before February 1, 2018.
