What is Health Career Exploring?



- A competitive program for high school sophomores, juniors and seniors who want to learn about health careers at St. Elizabeth Hospital; by observing the workplace, performing hands-on activities, and talking with health practitioners
- Explorers meet one weeknight a month October through March at one of the St. Elizabeth locations from 5:30-7:30 pm (students are assigned to either a Wednesday or Thursday)
- Students will learn about interdisciplinary care through medical scenarios, patient simulators and health professionals' personal stories
- Students will perform activities such as manipulating laparoscopic and robotic instruments, practicing therapy techniques, performing lab tests and simulation activities

The cost is \$20 and up-to-date immunization and medical records are required.
