CREDIT CAMP

Dear Parents and Students,

Cooper High School offers a credit recovery program for students who have an "I" (Incomplete) final grade of 60-69% in certain courses. The Credit Camp is designed to assist students who did not receive a full credit in a required class they have already taken. Students who fail a class with a final grade lower than 60% must take summer school to recover that credit.

Credit Camp will be a total of 4, four-hour sessions [16 hours]. The student will attend all 4 sessions until the Credit Camp course is complete and the assessments are passed with a minimum score of 70%. Students will receive a final grade of 70% on the transcript if they are successful, and there is no guarantee of success if a student does not demonstrate learning of the course content. Students may attempt to recover more than one credit, but must do so within the 4 day time frame by completing one course at a time. There is no cost associated with the program outside of the time commitment required.
