CREDIT CAMP

Dear Parents and Students:

Cooper High School offers a credit recovery program for students who have failed a class with a final grade of 60%-69%. Students who have failed an End of Course (EOC) class, denoted below, must have passed the EOC assessment but failed the class with a 60-69% in order to be eligible to recover the credit. For non-EOC courses, students must have failed the class with a 60-69% (there are no final exam score requirements). Students who fail a class with a final grade lower than 60% must take summer school to recover that credit. The Credit Camp is designed to assist students who did not receive a full credit in a required class they have already taken.

There will be a total of 4, four-hour sessions [16 hours]. Students will take the pre-test for the course which they are trying to recover the credit. Based on their results, they will have a course designed to address their areas of deficiency. The student will complete the necessary assessments and once they are ready to take the final exam, they may do so. This course is performance based so once a student shows mastery of the content by passing the final exam with a minimum score of 70%, the credit will be granted for the course and the student may be dismissed. Students will receive a final grade of 70% on the transcript. Students may attempt to recover more than one credit, but must do so within the 4 day time frame. There is no cost associated with the program outside of the time commitment required. Monday is only necessary for those who need an addition attempt to pass the final exam.
