



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PILE DRIVING • EXPECT NOISE

WHERE:

Crews will be performing pile driving work next to the northbound I-5 Crown Valley Parkway on-ramp.

WHEN:

- Crews will mobilize equipment as early as, Wednesday, Aug. 10.
- Pile driving will begin as early as Thursday, Aug. 11, and occur intermittently through early 2023. The retaining wall will be built in sections.
- Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

WHY:

- To construct the new concrete barrier and retaining wall at the northbound I-5, Crown Valley Parkway on-ramp.
- Pile driving is an engineering requirement to build this retaining wall.

WHAT TO EXPECT:


- The wall construction will be completed in sections due to its length.
- Construction noise is expected.
- Approx. 800 piles are needed at this location.
- Construction of the retaining wall is anticipated to be completed mid-2023.

This work may be loud. The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.

WHAT IS PILE DRIVING?

Pile driving is a common method of constructing structure foundations. To support the structure, steel or concrete beams or "piles" are driven into the soil until reaching a hard layer of earth beneath the structure foundation.
