That's the spirit of the Maccabiah.

The Maccabiah torch will be extinguished at tonight's Closing Ceremony. But, for 1,127 members of Team USA, the memories of the 20th World Maccabiah Games will burn brightly forever.

Maccabi USA's motto is "Building Jewish Pride Through Sports." Rabbi Irwin Kula, Team USA 2009, has said that "The Maccabiah is the healthiest engagement with young people that I have seen in American Jewish life."
