



A year with [Johnson Service Corps](#) is an opportunity to dedicate yourself to the work of service, social justice and spiritual growth. It's a time to learn more about your faith, yourself and the world. It's a time to reflect, pray, and consider what is next; all in a well-supported community of your peers.

JSC is accepting applications from young adults (ages 21-28) for a service year in the Durham - Chapel Hill, NC community. The program runs from August 2022 through July 2023. Applications must be received by June 1, 2022.

Corps members live together in community and are placed at nonprofit organizations, where they volunteer for 32 hours each week. Our partners offer a wide range of social justice placements; read more about them [here](#). The remainder of the Corps members' time each week is spent together in formation, including leadership training, professional development, and spiritual formation.

Housing is provided, along with a shared grocery budget, a personal stipend, funds for professional development, and health insurance if it is needed. Upon completion of the full year, corps members also receive a bonus to help with their moving expenses and transition out of the program.
