Monday, Oct 24	Corn Pollen Ceremony with Cathlena Plummer at GSM; Learn about their work, history of GSM, tour Soap Making Industry and gardens. Afternoon drive to Chinle for Canyon de Chelly Rim Tour followed by dinner at Thunderbird Lodge. Circle Gathering; overnight there.
