



The Beblon G. Parks Episcopal Church Women Youth Endowment Scholarship Award

The Beblon G. Parks Episcopal Church Women Endowed Scholarship is named in honor of Beblon G. Parks, a St. Philip's parishioner, and the first African American president of the Episcopal Church Women of the Diocese of Virginia.

Purpose

The Beblon G. Parks Episcopal Church Women Endowment Scholarship Award is presented to a youth who has been cited for extraordinary achievement locally, nationally or internationally. The youth may be recognized by educational, religious, social, civil, political, athletic, or fraternal organizations for activities and/or actions. The scholarship is awarded to an active youth member of St. Philip's Episcopal Church and may be used to support post-secondary education and/or Episcopal Church camp.

Eligibility

The youth must be an active member of St. Philip's Church, must be or have been an active participant in at least one church organization (church school member, acolyte, choir member, girl scout, etc.), and must be engaged in educational, social, civil, political, athletic, or community based activities.

How to Apply

Application forms will be available beginning in April of each calendar year. Applicants may self-nominate, be nominated by a parishioner or by a church organization. Completed application(s) shall be submitted to the ECW Scholarship Committee Chairperson

Application Deadline

Typically, the last Sunday in May

Award Presentation

Award may be presented annually on Youth Sunday in the month of June.
