## A 5-day Learning Experience to Cuba

### November 19 – 23, 2019

The five-day/four night's trip will focus on providing support to the Cuban people, as intended in sec. 515.574 FR U.S Department of the Treasury OFAC guidelines. Accommodations will be at a private waterfront residence in the Miramar section (**Only 10 spots available**). Price includes 5-days/4nights, ground transportation, a welcome and farewell dinner, breakfast each morning and museum admission. Our detailed itinerary includes personal interactions with locals and emphasis on learning about the lifestyle education and future of women in Cuban society.

**Note:** The Learning Experience to Cuba is very active, requiring participants to be physically fit to fully enjoy all the experiences. This itinerary has some strenuous activities which may include such things as: extensive walking tours, transfers over uneven and dusty terrain, high altitudes, early morning departures, late night activities, or extreme temperatures.

- Visit Jaimanitas and meet Fuster and learn about his community project as a ceramiist
- Meet Maggie Florez and Blanca Muster – lecture about the status of women in Cuba
- Welcome Dinner Restaurant RioMar (included)

- Visit Fine Arts Museum Cuban Collection and learn about art history
- Lunch in Paseo del Prado (on your own)\*
- Visit El Quitrin, a women's project in the Old City meet director Nadia Gonzalez
- Walking tour and visit to Cathedral and Plaza de Armas, colonial period
- Dinner on your own\*

- Visit Nobel Prize laureate Ernest Hemingway House, Finca Vigia
- Stroll the streets of Cojimar, a seaside fishing village the backdrop of Old Man & the Sea

- Learn about the work of Salvador and his graffiti art at Callejon de Hammel
- Panoramic view of Old Havana from from el Cristo de la Habana and Morro Castle
