### ***May Crowning***

Like October, May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. In addition to singing the traditional Easter antiphon in honor of Our Lady, the Regina Caeli (Queen of Heaven) at Mass, we will also have a May Crowning. This is the venerable custom whereby a crown of flowers is placed on a statue of the Blessed Mother. The May crowning will take place at all Masses this Mother's Day weekend (May 11-12).
