The Apostle's Creed (ALL)

I believe in God,
the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;
he descended into hell;
on the third day he rose again from the dead;

he ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty;
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the holy catholic Church,
the communion of saints,
the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body,
and life everlasting.
Amen.

For each of the five decades

On each "Our Father" bead of the rosary, pray:

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray:

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Oración para las cinco décadas del Rosario:

En la cuenta grande, donde usualmente se reza el Padrenuestro, rezaremos la siguiente oración:

Padre Eterno, te ofrezco el Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad de tu amadísimo Hijo, Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, como propiciación de nuestros pecados y de los del mundo entero.

En las siguientes cuentas, donde usualmente rezamos el Ave María, diremos la siguiente oración:

Por su dolorosa Pasión, ten misericordia de nosotros y del mundo entero

Esto lo repetiremos durante las 5 decenas del rosario.

Concluding prayer (repeat three times- ALL)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.
