## CHANGES TO THE DIVINE SERVICE

Beginning the weekend of Sept. 8-9, Trinity Lutheran ChurchSchool will be incorporating changes to the Divine Service.

After discussion and study by the Elders and Pastor Golter, it was decided that Holy Communion will be offered in every Divine Service. Currently, Trinity offers Holy Communion on the first and third Sundays of the month as well as days of the festivals, Christmas, Transfiguration, Easter, etc.

The individual's own hunger and desperate need will determine whether to partake in the Lord's Meal.

The Bible urges a continual, repeated and frequent offering of the Lord's Supper (1 Cor. 11:24).

The Holy Spirit does not say every day, every other day, or even once a year. "Often" teaches the need of the Supper for every sinner, letting the hunger of a Christian be the deciding factor.

Luther writes in the Large Catechism. "We must never regard the sacrament as a harmful thing from which we should flee, but a pure, wholesome, soothing medicine that aids you and gives life in both soul and body. For where the soul is healed, the body is helped as well. (Part V, par. 68).

To accommodate this change, the 10:30 a.m. Divine Service will be changed to 10:45 a.m. on Sundays. This change will help greatly with our Sunday School hour, where requests have been made for a longer time to teach the Bible to God's children – both big and small.
