Through research, we learned that of the 23 billion texts sent each day, there is a 98 percent open rate. In addition to reaching firsttime guests and returning visitors, we also can use this service to reach out to congregational members and ministry teams. During Pastor Golter's travels around Trinity Lutheran ChurchSchool, he poses the question to students: What does the word Amen mean? The response comes quick and boisterous: The truth!!
