

IMPORTANT STRIKE VOTE INFORMATION

DATE: Monday, September 9, 2019.

WHO CAN VOTE: All current members, both **permanent and casual**, of CUPE Local 4222 are entitled to vote. You are also eligible to vote if you are on Parental Leave, Personal Leave or Sick Leave.

You ***MUST*** be a member in good standing to vote! Newly hired Casual members must be able to prove that they have worked at least one shift prior to September 9, 2019. Bring a TVARRIS print out as proof of having worked that shift. We will be checking our current membership lists.

WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING: The Local is required to check ID and ensure that each member is currently employed by the Thames Valley District School Board in order to give you a ballot.

CUPE 4222 membership cards or a current pay stub would be the best way to prove you are an TVDSB employee. New hires can bring their Offer of Employment letters. Bring an additional photo ID as well (Driver's license, Health Card)

Presentations will be at 9 am, 12 pm, 3:00 pm and 5:30 pm.

Union representatives will be available all day to answer your questions relating to the vote.

Information regarding Central Bargaining items is **CONFIDENTIAL** and must not be distributed outside of these strike vote meetings. Information will be provided to assist you in making your voting decision.

Results of the central bargaining votes will be confidential until all votes are completed and will be released to the 55,000 CUPE members in Ontario by the Ontario School Board Council of Unions and CUPE Ontario.
