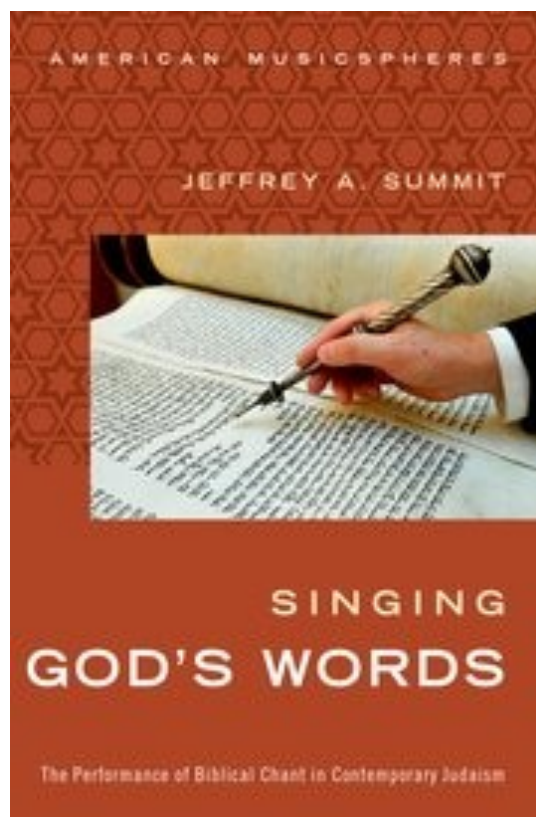
Welcoming Rabbi Summit

Rabbi Jeffrey A. Summit holds rabbinic ordination from Hebrew Union College and a Ph.D. in ethnomusicology from Tufts University, where he serves as Research Professor.

He is the author of *Singing God's Words: The Performance of Biblical Chant in Contemporary Judaism* (Oxford University Press, 2016) and *The Lord's Song in a Strange Land: Music and Identity in Contemporary Jewish Worship* (Oxford University Press, 2000). He teaches widely about music and Jewish identity, and was the Director of Tufts Hillel for over 20 years.

Rabbi Summit has also recorded, compiled, and annotated the CD *Abayudaya: Music from the Jewish People of Uganda* for Smithsonian Folkways Recordings. This CD was nominated for a GRAMMY Award for best album in the category of Traditional World Music. His CD with video, *Delicious Peace: Coffee, Music and Interfaith Harmony in Uganda* (Smithsonian Folkways Recordings), examined the role of music in peace building in a Muslim, Jewish and Christian Fair Trade coffee cooperative and was awarded Best World Music CD by the Independent Music Awards.

His current research focuses on music and identity, music and spiritual experience, music and advocacy, and the impact of technology on the transmission of tradition. In addition to work and family, he is passionate about hiking, singing and playing instruments with strings.

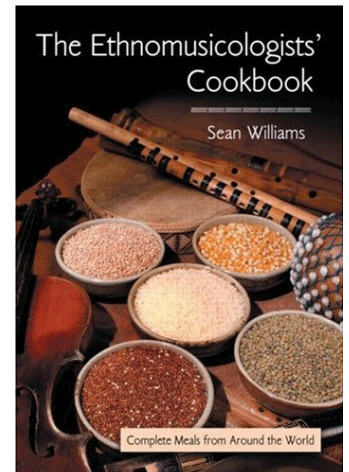

10:15 Joint Shabbat Service (d'var Torah by Rabbi Summit)

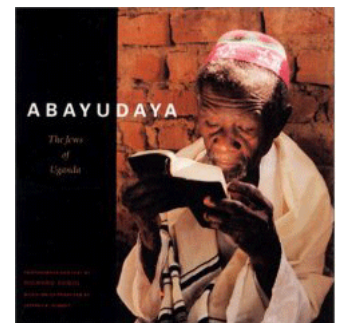
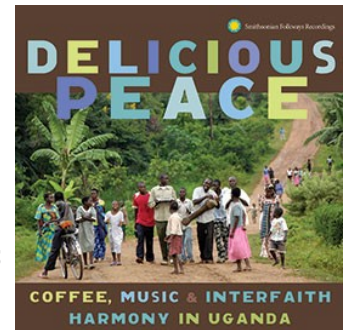

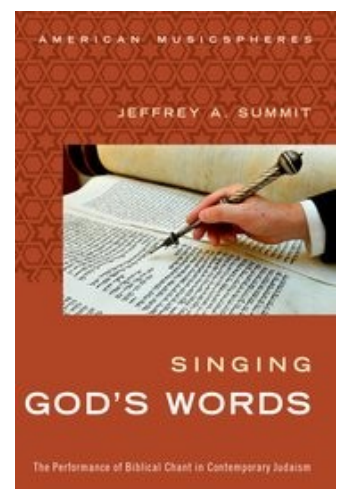
