

# Findorff | COVID-19 UPDATE

## ILLINOIS POLICY – MARCH 18, 2020

**As of Tuesday, March 17, 2020 the state of Illinois was declared a community of transmission by the CDC.**

Effective immediately, travel to or from the state of Illinois by Findorff employees, subcontractors, and suppliers is restricted.

- Employees that live in Illinois and travel to Wisconsin for work must adhere to the CDC guidelines of self-quarantine (14 days), before returning.
- Employees that live in Wisconsin and travel to Illinois for work, will follow CDC guidance of visiting a community of transmission and self-monitoring (see below).
- Employees that live and work in Illinois will follow CDC prevention and self-monitoring.
- If you have been to Illinois, you are prohibited from entering a Findorff Wisconsin jobsite or office.

We want to reiterate that Findorff is adhering to the CDC guidance to service our projects, employees and community. If you have traveled to a [community of transmission](#) in the past 14 days, please refer to the following guidance on how to self-quarantine (if presenting symptoms) and self-monitor (if not presenting symptoms):

***Self-quarantine:** means do not go to school, work, public areas, or attend large gatherings, such as parties, weddings, meetings, and sporting events.*

***Self-monitor:** If possible, take your temperature twice a day with a thermometer. A fever is typically a temperature of 100.4°F or greater. Symptoms of fever may include feeling unusually hot for no reason, having chills or having the sweats. Watch for fever, cough, or trouble breathing.*
