Club application due by March 31st. Club notified of approval to participate by May 15th. Club must send a cheque for club portion of scholarship along with detail of recipient. (Name, Address, SIN# if exceeds \$500)	Foundation contribution of \$500 plus the club contribution to give the total amount of scholarship. (Physician, Nursing, Medical research, Pharmacist, etc.) Selection is made by a committee of distinguished Kiwanians and members of the Kiwanis Foundation of Canada board.	Student application form with references, grades and short essay are required by March 31st Application form	2 x \$5,000 Scholarships available annually. Organized Youth Program Grant	When a club provides a minimum \$1000 donation to an organized youth program (I.E. Boys and Girls club, Scouts, Guides, Navy League, etc.) the foundation will add an additional “top-up” of \$500 to that Youth Group. Club must have made minimum donation of \$15 / member to be eligible to participate.	Club must provide proof that it has provided funds to an Organized Youth program” along with request for reimbursement. Apply via email or Canada Post	Club must have already made the minimum donation of \$1000 to the organized youth program. Maximum “top up” of \$500. Community Outreach Grant	The Community Outreach grant is designed to assist your club address some of the basic and unserved needs of the less fortunate children and youth in the community. (I.E. homelessness, food insecurity, warm clothing, mental health, drug addiction), focusing on youth. Club must have made minimum donation of \$15 / member to be eligible to participate. Maximum of one grant per club Priorities will be given to Kiwanis led projects with significant member participation.	Club application is due by May 31st. The application must include a community needs assessment, the anticipated need and impact, the project approach and timelines, the degree of Kiwanis participation, any partnerships, the total budget, and the amount contributed by the Kiwanis Club The club will be notified afterwards if your application has been approved. Apply via email or Canada Post	Foundation will match up to a <i>maximum of \$3,000 per club</i>. There is a total of \$35,000 available overall for this grant program. This is a matching grant so proof of club expenditure must be provided prior to reimbursement.	Kiwanis Community Outreach

Environmental Grant	The Environmental Grant is designed to assist Kiwanis Clubs in addressing environmental oriented issues in the community with support of youth (i.e. community clean up, planting trees, recycling, etc.) Club must have made minimum donation of \$15 / member to be eligible to participate. Preference will be given to projects that involve youth ... (Either a Kiwanis SLP club or other Youth Organization) Project must be sponsored by the Kiwanis Club – This is not a financial contribution to an outside organization.	Club application is due by May 31st. The club will be notified afterwards if your application has been approved. Application must include the club involved, a description, the impact anticipated, other parties involved, the total budget and the amount the Kiwanis club will contribute. Apply via email or Canada Post A post project report must be submitted to the Foundation, outlining the impact and results within 1 year of conclusion. This	Foundation will match up to a maximum \$3,000 per club There is a total of \$15,000 available for this grant program.
