Community Spirit - RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Can be a business, organization, club, or not-for-profit
Major activities must take place within the province of Alberta, and Head Office must be located within the City or County of Camrose.
Members of the Chamber’s Executive Committee or Small Business Committee are not eligible to be nominated.
Both Chamber members and non-members are eligible for nomination.

Customer Service- RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Employees of all industries within the City and County of Camrose qualify for this award.
Nominee must work within the boundry of Camrose County.
Nominees can be employees of both member and non-member businesses.

Ambassador - RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

The nominee must be affiliated with a Chamber member business or organization, and be a resident of the City or County of Camrose
Has a combination of current and past activity that spans several years. The most recent activity must have taken place in the last 3 to 5 years.
Is involved in a diverse range of projects and activities but not be financially gaining from involvement with community initiatives.
Is committed to the future of the local area and works to grow/develop the ways in which our area can meet the needs of residents & visitors and is not involved as a volunteer because it is an expected part of their job, unless involvement far exceeds what might be expected from an employer. Provides an enthusiastic presence both inside and beyond the borders of our local area, to champion and highlight what we have to offer.

Woman In Business - RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Individual must be a resident of the City or County of Camrose and have conducted business for a minimum of three years.
Major business activity must take place within the province of Alberta.
Head Office must be located within the City or County of Camrose.
Members of the Chamber’s Executive Committee or Small Business Committee are not eligible to be nominated.
Nominees cannot be nominated in two categories in same year.
Both Chamber members and non-members are eligible for nomination.

Young Entrepreneur - RULES OF ELIGIBILITY

Individual must be a resident of the City or County of Camrose and have conducted business for a minimum of three years.
Major business activity must take place within the province of Alberta.
Employ Albertans to produce goods and/or provide services.
Members of management, on your board, or in your employ cannot serve on the Alberta Business Awards of Distinction judging committee for this category.
Two or more persons may be nominated if their contributions to the business are considered equally significant.
Nominee MUST be under the age of 35
nominee MUST have played a direct and primary role in the planning and establishment of the business, abd currently be operating it in a leadership capacity.
business must demonstrat financial viability and sound potential for growth.
