BOARD MEMBER EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Thank you very much for your interest in running for the Alamo Ranch Community Association Board of Directors. Below we have provided a brief description of the expectations and responsibilities of the Board Members once they are elected.

The Board Members for the Alamo Ranch Community Association are volunteers for the community that devote their time to conduct the business of the Association on behalf of all community members. There is no benefit or monetary package that comes along with the position, aside from the appreciation of the community and the management staff. Volunteers agree not to predispose outcomes, or to allow individual bias to influence decisions. Volunteers shall endeavor to allow information to guide the process, and will attempt to make informed decisions whenever possible. Each volunteer agrees and understands by accepting this nomination that they accept the duty to ARCA and its members.

Volunteers will be made aware of privileged information as part of their duties, and hereby agree that information and/or undeveloped work shall not be disseminated or shared outside the group without prior express written authority.

All Volunteers shall:

- 1. Strive to ensure that the goals and objectives of ARCA come first;
- 2. Believe in the purpose and the mission and vision statement of ARCA, and act in a responsible and prudent manner;
- 3. Share individual opinions in a professional manner;
- Welcome all input without regard from where it originated, and express any challenge directed at the opinion, not any person;
- 5. Conduct all deliberations in a reasonable manner with professional decorum, and support decisions made by consensus;
- 6. Commit to attend monthly Board meetings, which may include an Executive Session and a Regular Session. Both of these meeting are typically held consecutively;
- 7. At all time be courteous to all Members, Staff, Volunteers and Vendors, and extend courtesy and consideration to anyone encountered in the Association;
- 8. Be punctual for all meetings; provide reasonable notice in the event they are unable to attend a meeting or to timely complete an assignment
- 9. At all times be an advocate for ARCA.
- 10. Invest an interest in serving the community where you live for a one to two (1-2) year term.
- 11. Be committed to uphold the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&Rs) of Alamo Ranch Community Association.
- 12. Have the ability to listen and make informed decisions, as well as being able to communicate with other homeowners.
- 13. Have ownership of a unit in the Alamo Ranch Community Association.
