#### WHAT IS INTERGENERATIONAL MINISTRY?

Intergenerational ministry isn't about adding another program or putting an end to segregated ministries. It's a way of life—being God's family in a way that values, equips, and includes all ages. It's about belonging. Its cultivating a culture in which faith in God is nurtured and relationships are fostered as all ages learn and grow, serve, worship, and fellowship together.

#### BECOMING

Intergenerational ministry welcome children, emerging adults, those in recovery, single adults, widows, single parents, teens whose parents are not around, the elderly, those in crisis, empty nesters and struggling parents of young children into a safe place to be formed into the image of Christ.

#### LEARNING & GROWING

Building on what our congregation is already doing to provide opportunities for people of all ages to "know and beknown" by each other, both in small group gatherings and large group settings.

#### SERVING

When people of all ages have opportunities to serve together locally and/or globally, helping others, seeking justice, and sharing God's love, wonderful things start to happen: Faith is formed as people of all ages work side by side in shared experiences, praying together and encouraging each other.

#### WORSHIP

Weekly worship gatherings are the family reunions of God's people. We gather as one body to praise God, find rest in God, be reminded of our hope in God, hear our call from God, and leave equipped by God.

#### FELLOWSHIP

Everyone comes together after service for lunch or snack fellowship. A Kid's Table monthly has special activites.

# ARLINGTON FIRST STEPS-6 MOS-PRE-K The little ones start in the nursery at 11am with songs, stories and play together. A 6<sup>th</sup> grader-Youth assists leader Josie.

#### ARLINGTON KIDS-K-4TH GRADE

The Arlington Kids start in the worship service where they serve, sing, hear a children's message and then go to their class for their "SUPERBOOK ACADEMY" video lesson and snack. A 7<sup>th</sup> grade or older assists the teacher each week.



#### ARLINGTON 5TH-6TH GRADE

The 5th-6th graders remain in the worship service, serving and participating in the children's message, then are given clipboards with activities or serve by helping in the nursery or fellowship hall.

#### ARLINGTON YOUTH

Those beyond 6th grade are encouraged to stay in the sanctuary and share in the ministries. They can serve by helping teach the Arlington Kids or serve in the fellowship hall. We are planning youth activities for the summer.
