How to Bring Your Privilege to the Equality and Inclusion Movement

In a lot of my post-book release interviews, the discussions have gravitated towards my post-transition experiences - all of which have everything to do with my rather unique take on male privilege: having had it for 25 years of my corporate career and then instantaneously losing it when I transitioned.

I explore (and call out, quite frankly) straight and gay white men to embrace their power and use it for raising up underrepresented groups like mine, noting that it is not a zero-sum game and discussing ways in which they can recognize it and channel it for the greater good.

Applying Design Thinking to DEIB Challenges

After becoming educated in design thinking and using it in other contexts during my management consulting career, it occurred to me that its human-centered nature would make it an effective tool in addressing human-centered DEIB challenges.

In this session, I will explain what design thinking is (a systematic human-centered approach to problem solving) and how I use the design sprint format (a design thinking tool) to help organizations begin a dialogue around DEIB and address other relevant topics. I will share some case studies and conduct a mini-design sprint with the audience to give them a chance to experience it.

Whether we call it remote, hybrid or distributed work, the pandemic accelerated this trend by 10 years. Research tells us that 60% of employees want a hybrid workplace, and 40% plan to be part of the "great resignation" if their employer does not provide this.

This session will present the challenges and opportunities as we approach the new workplace and provide participants with an immersive experience of working in virtual reality with conference centers, classrooms, shopping malls, offices, cinemas, ice skating rinks, boat rides, motorcycles, bikes and a game plaza to play actual board games.
