Dear Parent(s),

Welcome to Central Catholic High School. We appreciate your commitment to a faith-based education. Please carefully review the following information regarding physicals and health requirements.

It is mandatory for all **new, incoming students** to have a completed physical form, including immunization history, turned in before school begins. **A simple, sports physical will not be accepted for new, incoming students.** The physical form is available at your doctor's office. It must be completed and signed by a parent.

Furthermore, students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade are required to have all immunizations current. All new, incoming students are required to have a Diphtheria & Tetanus (Pediatric DT or Td) vaccine. Students entering grades 7 – 12, who have not already received the Tdap vaccine, are required to receive 1 Tdap dose regardless of the interval since their last DTaP, DT or Td dose. Illinois law states **all students entering 12<sup>th</sup> grade MUST have a meningococcal vaccine (MCV).** [Click here](#) for more information regarding this law. Unless a medical or religious exemption has been approved, or your child has an appointment to get the designated vaccines, your child will be subject to exclusion from school.

Lastly, physicals must be completed between **June 15 and August 1, 2017**. Then if your student plans to participate in sports during the school year, the physical will be active during all seasons.

The completed physical form should be turned in to the school, along with the other registration forms you will receive later this summer, August 2 – August 12 (Monday through Thursday only) from 8am – noon.
