IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CHILD'S CAFETERIA ACCOUNT

Cafeteria Account Balances: All students' cafeteria account balances will transfer to next school year. This includes students who will be attending Conestoga next year. Also, your child's PIN number will remain the same regardless of whether they are going to another school within the district. Checks should be made out to "TESD Cafeteria Fund".

Does your child have any medication in the nurse's office?

The District Medication Policy prohibits students from carrying prescription or nonprescription medications to and from school. **A parent or guardian must pick up any remaining medication from the nurse's office by the last student day.** The policy specifies that any medications which remain after the last day of school must be destroyed.

NOTE: Epinephrine auto injectors, asthma medications and diabetic supplies may be sent home with your child with parent permission as per district medication policy. An email to the nurse (coaryl@tesd.net) letting her know that the student will be picking up the medication is requested.

The medication policy also requires that a **NEW** doctor's order be written each year for a child to receive prescription medications at school. A form for the fall will be provided at the time of medication pickup for your convenience. If you should misplace it, a copy of the medication form can be downloaded from the district's web page, found under "Student Health Services".

No medication will be accepted in August without an order to accompany it.
No exceptions will be made.

Don't forget to stop at the Nurse's Office to pick up any remaining medications by Friday June 15.

Students who are interested in playing sports for TEMS next school year are reminded that paperwork must be completed before you may participate. The paperwork includes a physical exam by a physician after June 1, 2018. The necessary paperwork is available on the TEMS website or in the Main Office.

6th and 7th Grade Required Vaccinations for 2018-2019

6th Grade- PA School Health Law states that children entering 6th grade must have a physical examination completed and on file in the nurse's office. Please provide documentation to the nurse ASAP upon completion of the exam.

For attendance in 7th Grade-

PA School Health Law requires that all students **MUST** have the following vaccinations **PRIOR to the 1st day of 7th grade or risk exclusion:**

- 1 dose of tetanus, diptheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap)
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

If your student has NOT had these vaccinations and is not due for a well visit, please call your health care provider's office & request a nurse visit specifically for immunizations. These appointments are typically quicker to schedule & are often at no added cost to you. Other options to obtain these vaccinations include the Chester County Health Dept., many area Urgent Care locations, or clinics within pharmacies.

Additionally a Dental Exam is also state required for 7th grade. Forms to be completed by your family dentist can be found on the TESD website under "Student Health Services".
