Description of TEMS PTO Opportunities to Volunteer

IN THE SCHOOL AND/OR WITH KIDS AROUND...

Health Screenings – As with the elementary schools, TEMS will measure height, weight, sight & hearing. Volunteering for this is an ideal time to see TEMS students (up close).

Picture Day – Parents help usher the students through the photographer lines. Typically 1-2 hour shifts.

School Store – The TEMS school store, located adjacent to the cafeteria, is open every school-day from 11am–1pm. Students are allowed to shop during their lunch/activity period. Two hour shifts are assigned.

Dance Chaperone – Grades 7 & 8 have several dances throughout the year; Friday nights in the TEMS Café. Parent volunteers help during the dance.

MLK Day Casserole Drive – On the Tuesday after Martin Luther King holiday, the PTO collects hundreds of frozen casseroles that are immediately distributed to local shelters and food banks. Parent volunteers help with collection (7-8am).

5th & 6th Grade Social Event –The Friday of Spring Teacher Conferences (during ½ day), a social event is planned for Grades 5/6. Typically, this is out of school (Arnold's, movie or bowling have been done in the past).

YOU MAY OR MAY NOT SEE KIDS...

Cultural Arts – Parent volunteers help with a variety of jobs from greeting speakers to planning and promoting.

8th Grade Recognition – This is held on the last day of school. Grade 8 parents help with invitation and decorating and Grade 7 parents help with hospitality (the day of the event).

MOSTLY OUT OF SCHOOL AND/OR ON YOUR OWN...

Parent Social & Silent Auction – This is the PTO's largest fundraiser of the year. It is held during a weekend night.

Hospitality/Baking – The PTO hosts a handful of events that require the donation of baked goods. There is no obligation to bake for every request.

Mini-Fundraiser Committee – This is a new committee which will plan and run mini-fundraisers throughout the year.

Barnes & Noble Book Fair – This fundraiser is held at Barnes & Noble in the Spring where the summer reading assignments are on display. Parent volunteers help with activities at the store.
