Dear Faculty,

If you have WTMC students enrolled in any of your classes, please be aware of the State of Michigan mandated testing program. This Spring, testing will occur over a three-week time frame from April 10 – April 25. As most of the testing is digital based, testing will be done in computer labs over various dates and times to accommodate all students. Students will be informed of the date and times of their testing at least two weeks before testing starts.

April 10 (WorkKeys) 11:30 am – 3 pm (Current 11th graders)

April 11 (SAT) 8:00 am – 1:00 pm (Current 11th graders)

April 18 (PSAT 10) 8:00 am – Noon (Current 10th graders)

April 18 (PSAT 9) Noon – 3:00 (Current 9th graders)

This spring testing is required for our WTMC students. Students have no choice but to take the exams on the dates and times indicated. Students will be expected to attend the WCC courses offered at any other time outside their designated testing time.

Washtenaw Community College, in the spirit of collaboration, recognizes and supports this required testing by accommodating WTMC students to make up required work, assignments and testing, this includes lab work. I want to thank you all for the efforts that you make to support this state testing and our WTMC students.
