**Hi Everyone!**

**We are so glad you are finally able to enjoy your property at Braeside! Although, in the near future things will not be the same as usual, it is a step in the right direction.**

**I have attached an excerpt from the [Emergency Measures Act](#). It outlines the parameters that allow us to currently be open.**

*Seasonal campgrounds*

- 3.1** Every person responsible for a seasonal campground shall ensure that,
- (a) campsites are made available only for trailers and recreational vehicles that,
    - (i) are used by individuals who do not have another residence in Canada and are in need of housing during the emergency period, or
    - (ii) are permitted to be there by the terms of a full season contract;
  - (b) only campsites with electricity, water service and facilities for sewage disposal are provided for use;
  - (c) all recreational facilities in the campground, and all other shared facilities in the campground such as washrooms, are closed; and
  - (d) other areas of the seasonal campground are closed to the general public and are only opened for the purpose of preparing the seasonal campground for reopening.

**We will be monitoring the front gate to ensure that the camp is only open and available to leaseholders and you will get a seasonal parking pass for your vehicle.**

**Please be advised that:**

- 1. NO guests are allowed on the grounds. Only leaseholders and their immediate family.**
- 2. Leaseholders alone may occupy their Braeside residence. They will not be able to rent or lend out their cottage or trailer.**
- 3. Social Distancing rules are still in place. (stay at least 2 metres (6ft) away from other people, no gathering in groups over 5 people)**
- 4. There is no access to public buildings and common spaces, including public washrooms and park equipment. You MUST be self-sufficient while at your cottage/trailer.**
- 5. If you have any illness or have been in contact with someone who is sick, please stay home.**

**Thank you for your help! Many of you have been volunteering your time and it is GREATLY appreciated. If you would like to volunteer, please contact the office.**

**Please be patient with us as we learn and comply with new health and safety guidelines, and also as we are working with a reduced staff this summer. We will get through this together!**
