Hi Everyone,

As part of the Province's plan for reopening the parameters of how we can open have changed again. We are now able to be open to rentals, and with the guidance of the Health Department, open our pool! **This means that you may now have guests, overnight guests and rent your cottage or trailer if desired.**

As we open up the campground to more people, we need to put more measures in place to ensure the safety of everyone on the grounds and to protect Braeside from scrutiny if ever we had an outbreak of COVID-19.

Guidelines for re-opening – Stage 2:

1. **As of June 26th, we will be manning the front gate daily.** This is the only way we can monitor who is on the campgrounds and ensure we can provide contact tracing to the Public Health Unit.
2. **Overnight guests of leaseholders MUST** register and receive a parking pass for the duration of their stay.
3. **Renters of leaseholder properties MUST** fill out and sign a form outlining the policies of Braeside Camp and receive a temporary parking pass.
4. **Guests of leaseholders and renters need be limited** to allowable social gathering numbers.
5. **Public washrooms will be open** as of Monday, June 22nd
6. **The pool will be open** for leaseholders and those renting accommodations or campsites. Guests of leaseholders or renters who desire to swim will need to register at the office and receive a daily pool pass at a cost of \$2.50 per person for ages 6 years old and up.
7. **One pool pass will be given to every leaseholder for their use and the use of their immediate family.**
- lost passes may be replaced for \$25.

We appreciate your cooperation and patience with us as we continue to work out the details to open Braeside safely!

1. Beaches, Parks & Camping

In Stage 2, Ontario Parks campgrounds and private campgrounds can also open for recreational vehicle, car camping and all other types of camping.
