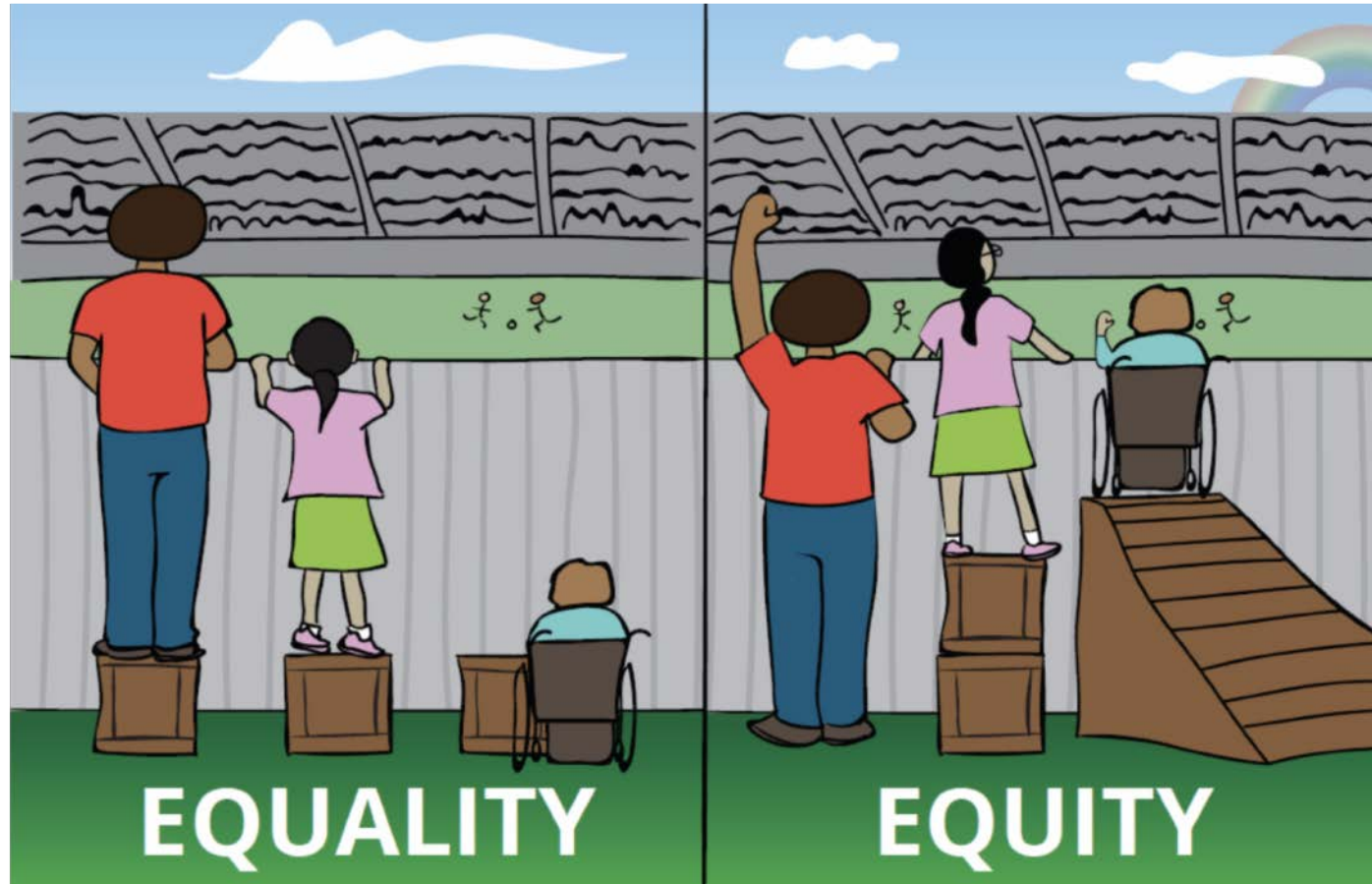

....but in time Sweet Alice and I got on famously. “You know why we like you, Chief?” She said, “**We see you. You see us.**” I loved that. I thought it was the vital message that one organization, one community, one family, one individual could give to another: **that no one is to be ignored, that every person needs to be acknowledged, that everyone needs to be protected and served and seen.**

Your dad was assassinated because he represented something.

Rafael Ramos was assassinated because he represented all of us. Even though, beneath the uninform, he was just a good man.

And maybe that's our challenge.

of who we are.**

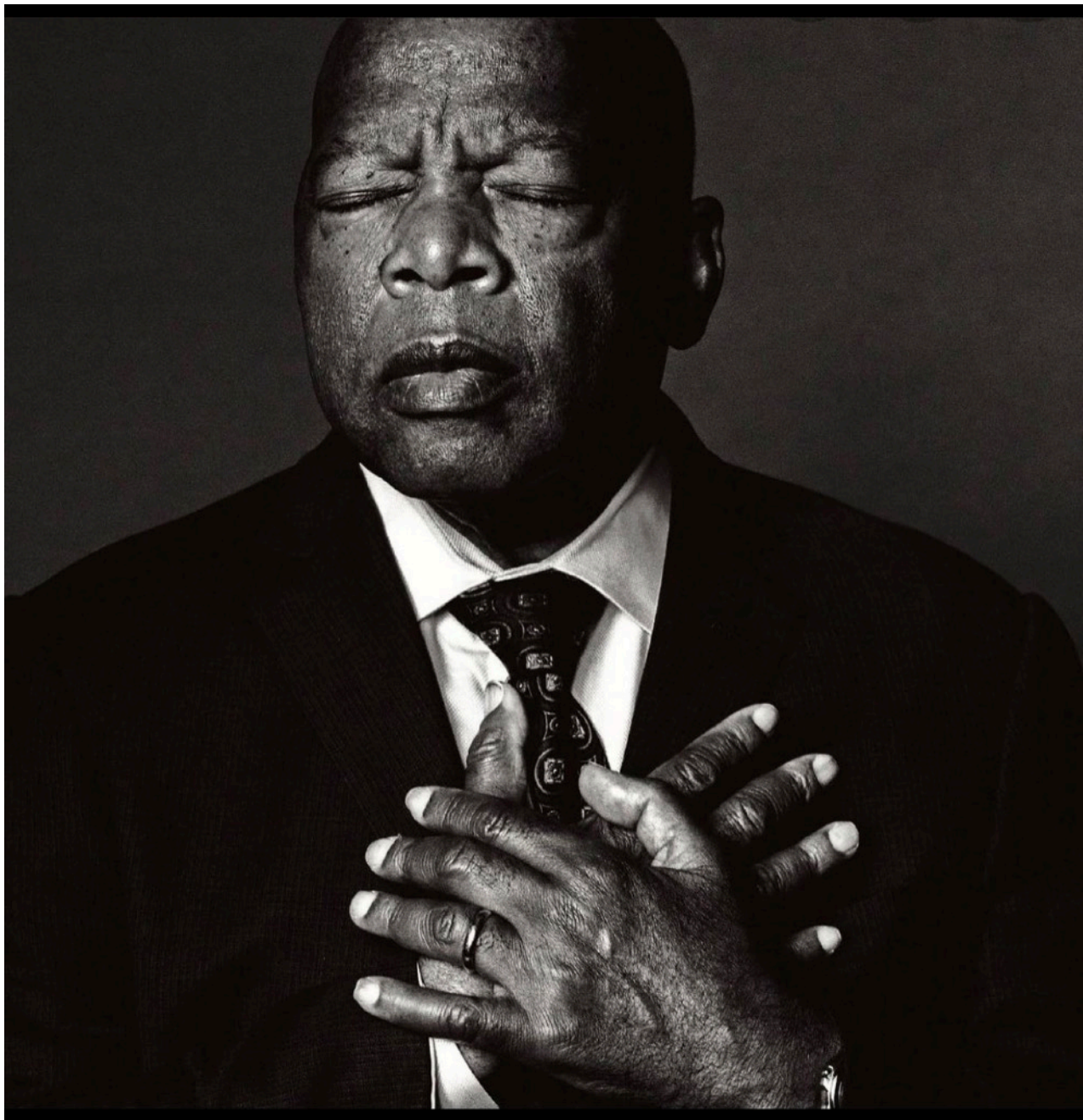

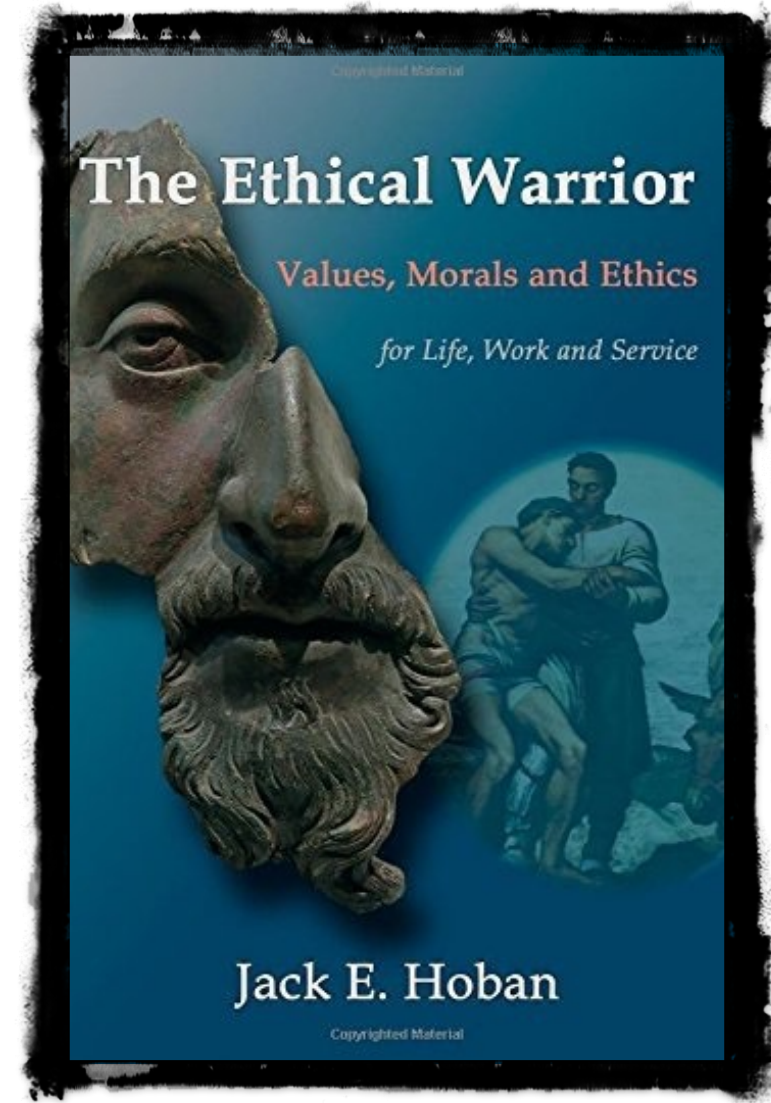
