# **General Information:**

## **Program Description**

Join us for an active, hands-on three-part series to learn effective strategies for teaching children with autism. We will cover topics that relate to families/caregivers in the home, staff in the classroom or home environments, and therapists working in a clinical setting. Each session will introduce basic behavioral teaching principles such as breaking skills down into small teachable units, building these smaller skills into more complex skills, using reinforcement strategies, measuring progress, and managing those difficult to manage behaviors.

## **Topics**

**Basic Teaching Principles I**—overview of autism, using discrete trials, prompting strategies, using motivational strategies

**Basic Teaching Principles II**—this session builds on Principles I and includes choosing skills, breaking skills down into teachable steps, generalizing and maintaining skills, measuring changes, moving skills from introduction to mastering skills

**Behavior Management Techniques**—identifying problem behaviors, understanding causes of behavior, selecting behavior change strategies, and evaluating changes
