

Levels of Participation

Level 1 – Start by finding out about the people on the bracket by using the library or the internet.

Level 2 – Research saints (using *Saintly Scorecard Definitive Guide to Lent Madness 2017* – pick up at the parish office),

- A. Just fill in the bracket and learn about these great people for yourself.
- B. Form a pool of your own among family/friends/coworkers/classroom/ministry group etc.
- C. Join the Parish Pool for \$5.00 * and be part of Operation Rice Bowl.**

- a. Fill out the Bracket (**make a copy to keep for yourself**),
- b. Turn in your **SIGNED** Bracket **with contact information** no later than **February 13, 2017**.
Put your SIGNED bracket and five dollars (if paying by check make it payable to St. Brigid of Kildare with notation of Lent Madness) in an envelope. Address it to **Lent Madness** and return it to the Parish Office or drop it in the collection basket).
- c. Go to lentmadness.org or follow the link from the St. Brigid of Kildare website to vote online **each weekday** for the saint of your choice **starting March 2**.
- d. Watch the Big Bracket on the kiosk as the saints move forward each week and our 10,000 hour thermometer keeps rising during Lent, 2017. Be sure you track your time spent on studying and reflecting on these wonderful people and record it on our 10,000 prayer challenge.

The winner from the Parish Pool will win the distinction of being St. Brigid's 2017 Lent Madness winner and **Guardian of the Golden Halo** until the 2018 contest! Do your part to spread the glory around.

*75% of the money collected from the Parish Pool will go to our parish collection for Operation Rice Bowl and 25% will go to the winner's designated charity.
