- Volunteer together for a project – Catholic Charities, Good Works, food drives, road clean up
- Plan and deliver meals to a family with a new baby or to someone who's sick, grieving or incapacitated
- Go to daily mass together
- Study the Sunday readings and pray together
- Invite Father or one of the deacons to lead a discussion on a Church teaching
