In 2018, Mississippi passed a law protecting unborn children after 15 weeks of gestation, when a baby has a heartbeat, eyes that open, ears that hear and can move and kick. The law was challenged and the case, known as Dobbs v Jackson Women’s Health Organization, is being heard by the U.S. Supreme Court.
