

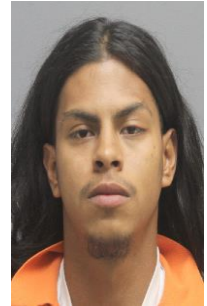

Updates

Armed Robbery *ARRESTS – On July 1, detectives concluded the investigation into the robbery that was reported to have occurred at Potomac Mills located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cl. in Woodbridge (22192) on June 7. While investigating the incident, detectives charged the two juvenile female acquaintances who were accompanying the victim and were able to identify and charge the two other males who committed the act. After consultation with Juvenile Court Services, the petitions against the two **15-year-old female juvenile** acquaintances resulted in formal action and will be handled through the court process at a later date. Additionally, the two male suspects, identified as a **17-year-old male juvenile** and Iverson **GALINDO VALLE**, were arrested.

**Continuation from the investigative update on the previous page.*

Armed Robbery [Previously Released] – On June 7 at 4:51PM, officers responded to Potomac Mills located at 2700 Potomac Mills Cl. in Woodbridge (22192) to investigate a robbery. The investigation revealed the victim, a 16-year-old male juvenile, and two female juvenile acquaintances were in a public restroom when one of the females allowed two additional males into the restroom. While inside the restroom, one of the males grabbed the victim and brandished a firearm before taking the victim's property. The victim eventually fled the restroom and contacted the police. No injuries were reported. While investigating the incident, officers recovered all of the victim's property except a pair of shoes. The parties involved are believed to be known to one another, and the incident does not appear to be random. No charges have been obtained at this time.
