Requirements: Local Valid I.D. and current Disposal Bill

NOTICE: Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic,

**Face coverings are required in accordance with guidance issued by the State of California.
Physical distancing of 6 feet between persons from different households must be maintained at all times.**

Each resident from Bethel Island is allowed to dispose of 5 cubic yards of material (approximately a full size pick-up truck with an 8ft x 5ft bed. Material stacked 3 1/2 feet high from the pick-up bed would equal 5 cubic yards). Disposal Service will accept any type of scrap metal (i.e. aluminum).

The following items will not be accepted.

- Dirt
- Liquid Waste
- Rock
- Electronic Waste
- Treated Wood
- Concrete
- Appliances (Refrigerators, Washing Machines)
- Hazardous Waste
- Tires

- **Bethel Island residents will be required to unload their own debris into the dumpsters.** Volunteers will be on hand to assist the elderly.
- **Items are to be separated.** Separating your items before arrival will allow you and the rest of the community to move faster through the line. Your help in doing this is important!

Any and all illegal dumping will be reported to the Contra Costa Sheriff's Office and the California Highway Patrol.
