Vinum founder, manager and winemaker

Mr. Bowles descends from a long line of Virginia farmers and is held to be the seventh-generational grandson of Colonel Peter Jefferson of Goochland and Albemarle. Bowles' pioneering vineyard, Montdomaine, was part of Jefferson's longtime friend and partner, Colonel Joshua Fry's Viewmont.

After a 37 year career as a Captain for both Pan American and United Airlines, in the late 60's Bowles became interested in winemaking and viticulture. He founded Montdomaine Vinyard, the oldest continuing commercial vineyard in Albermarle County in 1977 and Montedomaine Cellars two years later.

In spite of weather, pestilence and other numerous impediments, grape growing at Montdomaine Vineyard continues today.
