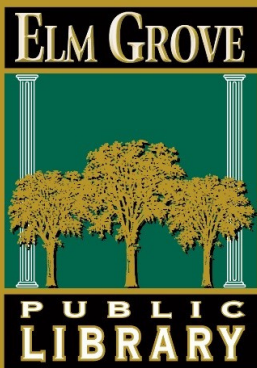

All you need is an internet connection, computer or mobile device, and your library card.

DIY Story Times - Monthly do-it-yourself story time packets are available both in the library and on the library website at [DIY Story Times](#). In addition to a collection of songs, rhymes and book suggestions, packets contain ideas for making the most of reading time with your child. For February, there is an additional bibliography of book suggestions for **Black History Month**.

Book Bundles - If you don't have time to browse for new children's books, or you just need fresh suggestions, book bundles are the answer! When you request a book bundle, a librarian will select 4-5 books for your child based on your preferences. The books will then be put on hold for you to pick up at the Elm Grove library or receive curbside, and you will be notified when the books are ready. This service requires a current library card from the Bridges Library System.

Kids' Choice Update - Students in grades 4-6 will begin voting for their favorite books from the Kids' Choice list on Monday, February 15. If you have been reading and you don't have a chance to vote at school, you can find the link for voting on the [Bridges Library System website](#) beginning on February 15th.

Winter Reading Update - In January, the Elm Grove Library participated in Beanstack's Winter Reading Challenge, "Books Like Us." We challenged our community to read at least **6,000 minutes** (all of us together) during the month and the **grand total was 9,120 minutes!** We may not win any of the prizes, but Elm Grove showed us they can rise to a challenge. Congratulations to everyone who participated!
