What is Cookie House?

Cookie House is SJS annual bake sale and **ONLY** fundraiser sponsored by SJS Home & School.

What are the bake sale proceeds used for?

Proceeds are used for various school and fun family events including Back to School Ice Cream Social, Trunk or Treat, Gingerbread House competition, Catholic Schools Week, Teacher Appreciation, Forensics, Mother/Son Bowling, Father/Daughter Dance, High Interest Day and More.

How can SJS Families Help?

1. Bake Cookies! We are asking each family to donate a minimum of 6 dozen homemade Christmas Cookies.

The more festive, the better!

2. Don't like to bake? Consider donating \$50 to help offset the cost of baking supplies.
3. Volunteer. Sign-Up for bake nights, set-up, clean-up, and day of Cookie House help.

Do we have to bake cookies?

Christmas Cookies are the primary focus, but candy (fudge, truffles, etc.) or other Christmas themed baked goods are always welcome.

What makes Cookie House a success?

Volunteers of course! In the past, volunteers have spent 55+ hours mixing, rolling, cutting out, and baking dough for over 400+ doz cookies. In 2022, volunteers spent over 250+ hours helping with decorating, set-up, sale, and/or clean up of the event.

How many cookies does it really take?

We've sold over 12,000 cookies, either donated by SJS families or prepared by bake night volunteers. In 2022, we sold approximately 245 pounds of cookies via the cookie tray presale.



Does volunteering for Cookie House go towards SJS family volunteer hours?

Yes! As an added bonus, families will receive an out of uniform pass for every (6) dozen cookies baked or every 2 hours volunteered.
